CBS staff learn more about the Constitution of Seychelles

The Central Bank of Seychelles recently organised a session about the Constitution of Seychelles for members of its staff, held at the Central Bank building on 28 May 2018.

The session, held in commemoration of the 25th Anniversary of the Constitution of Seychelles, aimed to provide an insight into our constitution to all staff in general and more particularly, enhance the knowledge of the staff who have the responsibility of monitoring and enforcing legislation that fall under the mandate of the Central Bank.

The main presenter was Mr Bernard George, Attorney-at-Law, who gave an overview of the origin of the concept of constitution, the historical journey and the rights which citizens of Seychelles benefit from. The staff were also presented with Article 40 of the constitution, which states the fundamental duties of all citizens.

The Central Bank of Seychelles remains committed to the continued knowledge development of its staff to ensure that it abides by the supreme law of the land in the discharge of its primary objective, which is to maintain domestic price stability.
