### NOTICE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The Central Bank of Seychelles (CBS) wishes to advise the general public that with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> February 2018, the 10, 25 and 50 Rupee banknotes of the previous series will cease to be legal tender and as such will no longer be accepted as a means of payment. The banknotes affected are as follows:



Up until 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the public may deposit the banknotes at their respective commercial bank or Seychelles Credit Union. Members of the public who do not have an account with a commercial bank or Seychelles Credit Union, may exchange these banknotes at the CBS during that period. Residents of Praslin and La Digue who do not have a bank account

are advised that the banknotes can be exchanged at any bank or branch of credit union on these islands until 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 only.

From 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 onwards, the public will only be able to exchange these banknotes at the CBS.

To perform this exchange, members of the public will be required to complete a form and submit a valid proof of identification.
