



PRESS RELEASE

Further to the announcement of the Finance Minister in the National Assembly on the 30th June, 2009, regarding cases that are pending under the previous Exchange Control Act, the Central Bank wishes to provide clarification on certain issues in this regard.

(1) What is meant by ‘pending?’

If foreign currency has been seized from your possession by virtue of the Exchange Control Act, and:

- (a) You have not been sentenced by the Court; or
- (b) Your moneys have not been forfeited to the State: or
- (c) You have not compounded your case;

then your case will be treated as pending and the foreign exchange confiscated will be refunded.

(2) Course of action

If you satisfy the conditions in (1) above then you should contact the Central Bank on the following telephone numbers 282004 or 282006 for assistance.

If you are in doubt as to whether your case is still pending please contact the CBS on the above numbers.

The Central Bank appreciates the co-operation of those involved and will assist in the best way possible.
