NOTICE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The Central Bank of Seychelles (CBS) wishes to advise the general public that with effect from 15th February 2018, the 10, 25 and 50 Rupee banknotes of the previous series will cease to be legal tender and as such will no longer be accepted as a means of payment. The banknotes affected are as follows:



Up until 14th February, 2018, the public may deposit the banknotes at their respective commercial bank or Seychelles Credit Union. Members of the public who do not have an account with a commercial bank or Seychelles Credit Union, may exchange these banknotes at the CBS during that period. Residents of Praslin and La Digue who do not have a bank account

are advised that the banknotes can be exchanged at any bank or branch of credit union on these islands until 14th February, 2018 only.

From 15th February, 2018 onwards, the public will only be able to exchange these banknotes at the CBS.

To perform this exchange, members of the public will be required to complete a form and submit a valid proof of identification.
